Hickam Field, Honolulu, with the U. S. Armed Forces. They left Cisco Saturday morning.

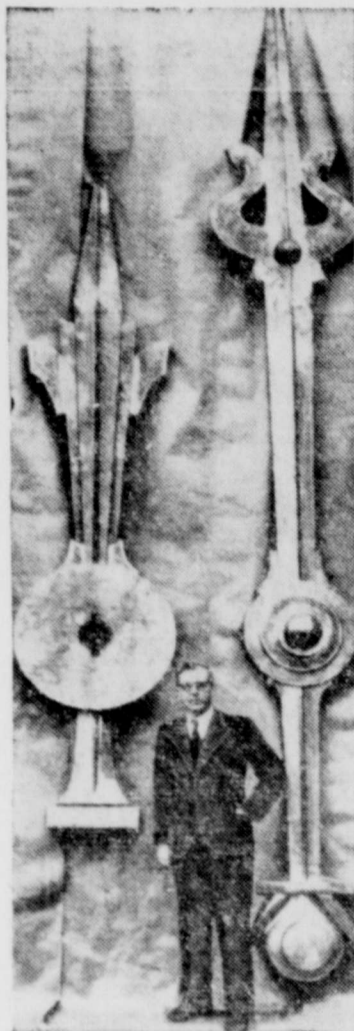

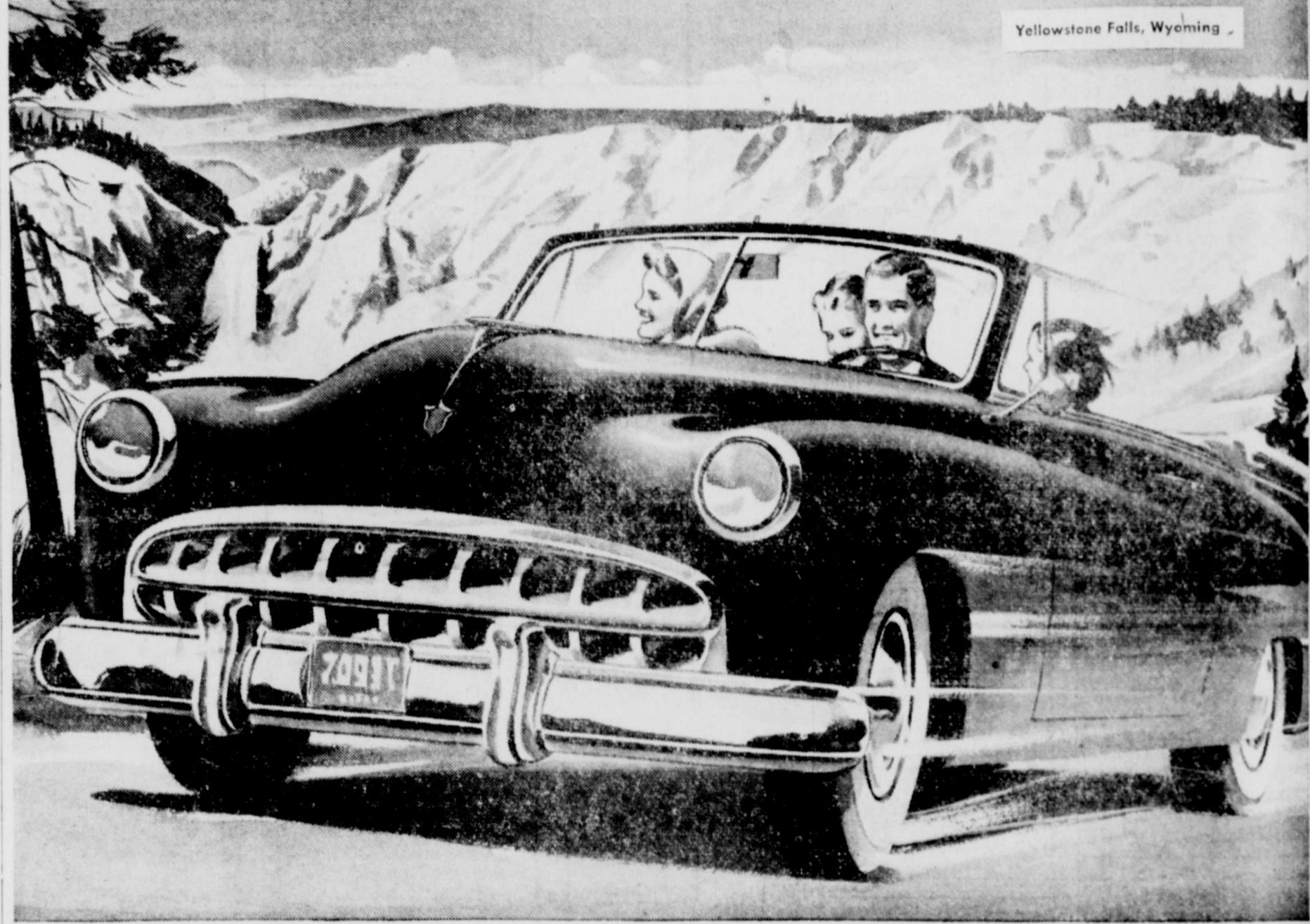
