"Milk drinks make an excellent party refreshment to serve to your 4-H Club, your Sunday School Class or at any other time when you want a refreshment that is not only good but also good for you," stated Rozelle Winston, assistant county home demonstration agent, Tuesday morning, Sept. 30, as an introduction to the leader training demonstration on making milk drinks given in her office.

Banana milk shake was the featured drink of the demonstration. It was suggested as a tasty way to get both fruit and milk into the diet. Mrs. R. C. Moore, adult leader of the Rising Star 4-H Club, said, "I think that my son, who plays football, will particularly enjoy this milk shake because it is even more nutritious than the plain milk shake he drinks to give him added energy."

"Banana milk shake is a refreshment that can be prepared in a short time and is simple enough for any age girl to prepare," stated Mrs. Marshall Berry of the Pleasant Hill community at the close of the demonstration.

The adult leaders of the girls 4-H Clubs meet once a month with the assistant agent to plan the program for the girls' second meeting in each month. Through the adult leaders the 4-H Clubs are able to achieve a broader program in the community.

Moses fumbled on the Henderson 35. The Wrangler line held, and the Cards punted to the Cisco 26. The Wranglers couldn't go and kicked to the Cardinal 40 as the first period ended.

The Henderson team couldn't make anything, and Cheek punted to the Cisco 20. Here, Denard fumbled and the Cards took over. Four plays failed, and the ball went over on downs on the Cisco 17. The Wranglers drew a 15-yard setback, and Suggs punted to the Card 45. Henderson picked up a first down and three passes failed. Cheek punted to the Cisco 18.

Lee made 10 yards on two bucks and hit Hatley with a pass for a first down on the Cisco 40. A penalty gave the Wranglers another first on Hendersons 49. Four plays failed and the ball went over on downs on the Card 41. After drawing a 15-yard penalty, Cheek hit Atkins with a 32-yard pass, and Langston drove to the Cisco 27. Atkins then got through to the 11. Langston and Cheek picked up a first down on the Cisco 1, and Langston scored. The kick was good.

The Wranglers took the third period kickoff and on the first play Moses raced 59 yards to score, but an offside penalty rubbed it out. Three Cisco plays failed and Suggs punted to the Henderson 31. The Cards failed to make two plays click and

passed to the Cisco 44. Atkins then ran 36 yards for a touchdown. Johnson converted.

The Cisco eleven took another kickoff on their 34. Lee hit Miller for six yards, and Buster Norman blocked Suggs' punt, recovered the ball and ran about 30 yards for a touchdown. Johnson kicked the goal.

The Wranglers took the kickoff on their 24. Four plays gained 9 yards and the ball went over on the Cisco 33. Four Henderson plays failed as the fourth period began, the Wranglers took over on downs on their own 30. Dyer intercepted a third down pass and raced to the Cisco 16. On fourth down, Cheek got through for a touchdown.

The remainder of the period was a defensive duel with frequent penalties.
