By ALBERT SNIDER, SR.

In the fourth century, through vived to the present day." the urgency of Cyril of Jerusalem, Julius I issued an order for an investigation to be made concerning the day of Christ's nativity, which resulted in an agreement by the theologians of the East and West upon the 25th day of December as the day. The chief grounds for their decision were the tables of the censors in the archives of Rome; and although in the opinion of some of the Fathers, there was not an authentic proof of the identification of the day, yet the decision was uniformly accepted, and from that time the nativity has been celebrated throughout the church on the same day.

There is no divine authority for the observance of December 25th, or any other day, in commemoration of the birth of Jesus. But since the day is generally observed as a festival, there is no impropriety in utilizing it as a day of religious observance, social cheer and benevolent deeds.

It may be well to remark here that among the northern nations the heathen festival of the birth of Sol was on the 25th of December, and that Christmas and that custom of making presents on Christmas eve, succeeded this heathen festival, retaining the name of Yule or Inul: i.e. the 'Wheel" or the revolution of the sun. The Roman Saturalla, or festival of Saturn, was also in December, and many of its features passed over finally into Christmas festivals.
