It can hardly be denied that everything that has been done in the way of legislation by the regular or called session could have been done in ten days.

The depositors have asked for a bank guarantee law, not a bond law with only the right to bring suit.

Such a plan as is proposed is, I believe, a sham and a fraud.

Probably the boldest, the most arrogant and most formidable lobby, made up of the combined selfish interests that has ever assembled at the capitol, gathered here upon the assembling of the thirty-first legislature to pester you and hinder and defeat the popular will.
