



- 1-2 cupful of Magnolia Shortening.
- 1 cupful of sugar.
- 1 cupful citron, Sun-maid raisins and nuts, chopped fine.
- 3 eggs, beaten light.
- 1 cupful of milk.
- 3 cupfuls of Admiration flour.
- 1-2 teaspoonful of Palestine salt.

Cream the shortening; gradually beat in the sugar, then the fruit and nuts, the eggs, and, alternately, the milk and the flour sifted with the baking powder and salt. Bake in a PYREX pan 8x12 inches. Sift two tablespoonfuls of granulated sugar over the top of the cake before baking.
