If we consider children less than
13 years old as the pediatric group, 13 years old as the pediatric group, as of February 1, 1990, there had
been 2,055 pediatric AIDS been 2,055 pediatric AIDS cases in
the UU.S., and every year $1,500-$ 2,000 infected babies are being born in the U.S.
How do these innocents get the AIDS virus? It is important to know that the most common risk factors for the women who are infected by the virus are (IVDU's), which make up about $49-52 \%$ of the cases. In 1988,
about $70 \%$ of the perinatally about $70 \%$ of the perinatally
(shortly after childbirth) trans(shortly after childbirth) trans-
mitted cases of AIDS were children of mothers who are injecting drugs
or they were in a close relationship with a drug abuser. ${ }^{2}$. Also unfortunately, a very sad reality is
the increasing number of pediatri the increasing number of pediatric
AIDS cases among sexually abused children, the most innocent victims of this madness.
