At the meeting of the West Texas Association at Wichita Falls t was reported that he has since expressed himself as opposed to a sow college, but in favor of four junior branch colleges to be located
in four different sections of the State. It is assumed by the advosates of the branch college that this virtually means that the authorities of Agricultur
next Legislature.
It would be unfortunate for sueh a fight to be precipitated in
the Legislature, and an effort should be made to reach some sort of understanding before that time. The West Texas Association should atcertain just where the directors of Agricultural and Mechanical
College stand, which should not be difficult. There is not necessarily a cognflict between the two points of view, for certainly it would be atablishment of our new institutions at this time, when the problem will be to work out a plan by which the State can see its way clear to
