BEAUMONT, Sept. 5.—The horribly mutilated bodies of Miss Bessie Carr, 16, and T. C. Rial, were found in a clump of woods near here today. The couple had been missing since they went for a ride in Rial's car after leaving a picture show Saturday night. The car was found Monday.

The bodies were laid side by side. The girl's head had been crushed by a blunt instrument and Rial had been shot. His clothing was headily torn as if he had put up a struggle against the unknown assailants.

The motive for the crime is unknown. The girl's home was at Houston, but she had been visiting her sister here for the past few days. She had not known Rial long, it is said.

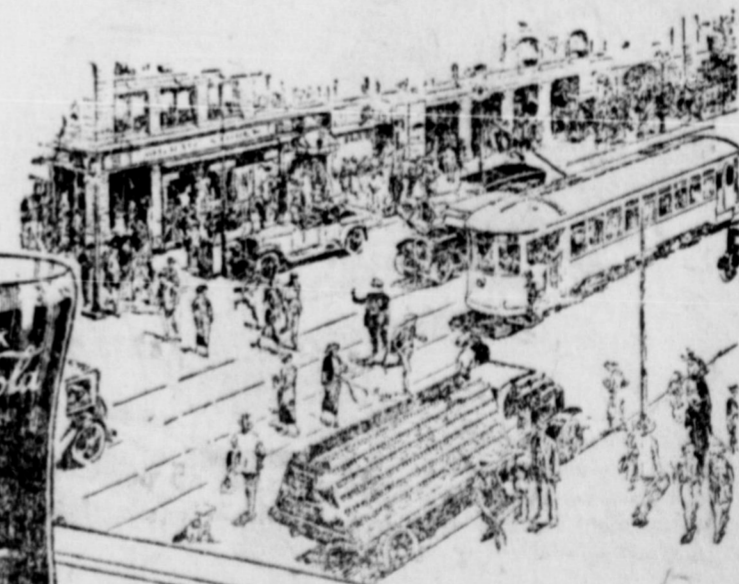
