Risk letters give investors an opportunity to seriously consider heir positions before making ypically a standard form that the investment representative and client complete together. The form includes the amount and description of the purchase and a brief customer wants to buy the security. f the security is sold by prospectus only, the investor also mus acknowledge in the risk letter that
he or she has received the prospectus and has been informed of any fee, commission or surrender charge that may apply to the ransaction.
The risk letter also emphasize potential risks, such as marke fluctuation or overconcentration in one industry or sector.
