She is filled with the wisdom of the world, and despise the beauty of the cross and biblical femininity.
Next is the difficult woman ( $19: 13 ; 21: 19 ; 25: 24 ; 27: 15-16$ ). Depending on your Bible translation she is described as quarrel some, brawling, nagging, contentious and Proverbs $25: 24$ says, shared with a quarrelsome wife" (and all the men said AMEN!). Finally is the immoral woman. This woman is mentioned in 57 verses in Proverbs and is referred to as an adulterous, a prostitute, a strange, and a foreign woman ( $2: 16-19 ; 5: 3-23 ; 6 ; 24-29$;
$6: 32-33 ; 7: 5-23 ; 22: 14 ; 23: 27-28 ; 27: 13 ; 30: 20)$. Many men have been wrecked by her ways, and she is to be avoided at all hasts. Sadly, though, this is the woman our world glorifies and asks to do half-time shows at Super Bowls, calls young women to follow in her footsteps. She fills the pages of Playboy and scenes of pomography leading men to a false hope of fulfillment in her.
