Parmer County's August 2012 payment totaled $\$ 62,108.71$, broken down as Bovina $\$ 11,446.85$; Farwell $\$ 14,257.64$; and Friona $\$ 36,404.22$. In August 2011, the tax payment total was $\$ 57,121.20$. Comparing tax receipts from the same period last year, payments were up $8.73 \%$, broken down as Bovina $28.98 \%$; Farwell $36.78 \%$ and Friona $-3.75 \%$. For the year, Parmer County cities have ceived a total of $\$ 393,954.75$ as compared to $\$ 377,463.47$ for the same period last year, a $4.36 \%$ change.

## Billions of years or six days? (pt 1)

BRETT HOYLE, Pastor, First Baptist Church Evolution says the world began an estimated 4.5 billion years ago, while the Bible says God created it in six days and rested on the earth is $10,000-6,000$ years old.
