thing thing in the world, after all, the announcers on TV made it sound i-
resistibe dragsters with tractor tires sitting in rows waiting to share their roar And roar they did! After the second one my friend and I anxiously looked for the guy selling ear plugs.
The concept behind a tractor pull is to pull a weighted sled for set distance. The further the tractor goes the weight moves up the
