WPA WORK ON FRIO

Judge Lander has been especially active durng his year in the County Judge's office in securing additional State funds for thee schools of the county and in securing the approv-al of the various WPA projects which will give employment for many of the unemployed men of the county. He has secured something like \$8.000.00 more of the state funds for the benefit of the schools under his supervision than has even been secured in the past and is glad to have been able to be of so much material service to the schools of the county. Although his salary as ex-officio county school superintendent is practically insignificant, he has found it necessary to devote more of his time and labor to that department of his office than he has to the office of County Judge.






