### THIRTIETH DISTRICT COURT IS HEARING CRIMINAL CASES

Five salesmen declared that they could not convict a defendant on circumstantial evidence when examined for their qualifications as jurors in the trial of Will Forshee, negro, charged with theft of property of the value of over \$50 in the 30th district court Thursday. Four of the number later qualified their answer. The fifth, however, maintained that no chain of circumstances could leave him without a reasonable doubt.
