# OMAR BURLESON A Quiet Man 

## Who Gets Things Done Receives Tributes From Washington

The President of the United States

QUIET - METHODICAL - COOL-HEADED ....
OMAR BURLESON is far from the flambouyant type, but states his views in quietly methodical fashion that has gained him the respect of colleagues in Congress. His 1963 attendance and voting record was 100 per cent, and since 1947 his attendance and voting record is 98 per cent.
OMAR BURLESON has always voted for the defense bills of this country; he voted for the income tax reduction bill; he introduced a bill to limit beef imports to this country: he introduced the first bill to limit oil imports; he introduced a bill for a COMPLETE embargo on trade to Cuba.
In his 18 years in Congress OMAR BURLESON has voted to reduce the federal budget from three to 13 BILLIONS each congressional term; as Chairman of the House Administration Committee he has consistently effected economy in committee spending (i.e. reducing Adam Clayton Powell's committee spending 50 per cent); he has always voted against foreign aid since the late 1940s and recent reaction in Congress is proving him correct. He voted against the Civil Rights Bill because in its present form it limits the freedom of all Americans he is for the constitutional guarantees regardless of status.
In 1961 the late President appointed him congressional delegate to the United Nations where he used knowledge gained as ranking member of the powerful Foreign Affairs Committee. He also is chairman of the Joint Committee on the Congressional Library and vice chairman on Printing.
Quiet, methodical and cool-headed, he is widely known in Congress as a quiet man who gets things done.
