Il makes sense to use adequate lighting for reading, working or for security, and it makes sense to do it efficiently.

Locate table lamps so they provide the most light and fewest shádows. When buying light bulbs, choose the right bulb for the job. Remember that the lumen rating tells you the light output of builbs. Watts tell you how much electricity is needed to produce that light. And bulb life is the estimated number of hours the bulb can be expected to vurn.

Where bulbs are difficult to change, choose a "long life" bulb which may have less lumens for its wattage, but
 will last longer.

Decorative lights call for less lumens and lower wattage. A photo electric cell or timer will regulate the use of security lighting.
