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PURGE THE SCHOOLS.

The most dangerous place to have an enemy of the government is in the schools of the country, as a teacher therein.

An illustration of this is found in the public schools of Chicago, where an order had been issued by the superintendent that the 250,000 children in the city's schools should, on Armistice Day, stand at attention for one minute.

That is the kind of teacher that has in many instances found a way into the public schools of the country.

Even in the great University of Texas, at the beginning of the war, the corps of teachers and instructors was found to be honeycombed with socialists and German sympathizers.

In a recent issue of a popular magazine there was a story which was of more truth than fiction, telling of a band of socialists striving to have their young women secure places as teachers in the public schools.

Even the text books used in the public schools have become tainted with "theories," too often tending to socialism rather than being made up of articles breathing patriotism in every line on the page, as was the case up to a few years ago.

Keep the schools clean. Find out if the teachers have a leaning toward socialism or other unpatrioticisms and get rid of them before they have an opportunity to contaminate the youth of the land.

STOP SPEEDING.

The city of Cisco has an ordinance prohibiting speeding of automobiles within the city limits.

It has reached a point where human life is no longer safe on the principal thoroughfares of this city.

It is not only in that particular block, but all over the city. All the people who drive automobiles do not violate the law.

Speeding can easily be stopped. Other cities have succeeded in putting an end to it.

year at Houston. Bigbee is a native Texan; graduate of the Sam Houston Normal and of Southwestern University, former student at the State University and teacher at Smithville, Kingsville and Dallas.

SOCIALIST TEACHER IN CHICAGO SCHOOL EARNS SUSPENSION

CHICAGO, Nov. 20.—Miss Frances Lloyd, a teacher in the city schools was suspended today by Superintendent Mortenson.

Superintendent Mortenson said Miss Lloyd did not deny that she failed to obey the orders for the observance of Armistice Day.

Miss Lloyd will be tried before the school administration committee.

NEW YORK, Nov. 20.—R. W. Bolling, brother-in-law of President Wilson and treasurer of the shipping board was named in connection with a forty thousand dollar bribe it is alleged the Staten Island Ship Building company paid to procure unusual favors from the board.

Referring to the charges Bolling said "there's not a grain of truth in it."

WASHINGTON, Nov. 20.—Chairman Benson of the shipping board, in a formal statement regarding charges of bribery made before the Walsh investigating committee against R. W. Bolling, treasurer of the board, declared Mr. Bolling's explanation was perfectly satisfactory.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 20.—Nearly half the total disbursements of the shipping board over a period of seventeen months, amounting to more than two billion dollars, were unsupported by proper vouchers, according to the audit corporation accounts submitted to Secretary Houston today by the comptroller of the treasury in his annual report.
