Full-day Pre-K working out well

editor@muleshoejournal.com The first year of full-day pre-kindergarten has been an overwhelming success, Dillman Elementary Principal Todd Newberry told MISD trustees on Monday.

"In all categories, we are seeing gains over what we experienced last year," Newberry said, noting that last year pre-kindergarten students went to one-half day of classes. This year they're attending full-day classes, five days a week. And the MISD has measured where the kids were

last year in comparison to where they are this year.

"Limited English speakers are gaining a greater ability to communicate in English," Newberry said. "All students are improving in their ability to use describing words, positional words and a general increase in vocabulary has been experienced.
