New Tariff Politics: Reversed Situation

| WASHINGTON (KFS) - Those unfamiliar with previous U.S. tariff struggles may not appreciate the political irony that now sees New England leading the fight to block or invalidate the Ford Administration's oil tariffs. <br> The purpose of the levy is to raise imported off prices, decrease U/S. consumption, encourage increased domestic petroleum production, and maks more self-sufficient in energy. <br> No one can blame the New Englanders for complaining about tariffs that will increase Northeastern oil costs while comforting the petroleum industries of Ohio, Wyoming, Mississippi, Texas, California, Alaska et al. But the administration's rationale rests on the national interest - the goal of increased petroleum self-sufficiency - and not on favoring or penalizing any particular region. <br> Ironically, New England should know the logic of tariffs much better than other sections. For more than a century, from the rise of Alexander Hamilton to the decline of Herbert Hoover, the tariff issue was one of the great inflammations of U.S. politics. As late as the early 1900 's, tariffs on foreign goods ayeraged 40 per cent and the federal government derived a major part |
