## Complete Transcript Of Morton News Conference

| EDITOR'S NOTE: Following is the complete transcript of a news conference held Wednesday morning by interior Secretary Rogers C. B. Morton in the ist National Room of The First National Bank. <br> Morton's first comments are a critique of a Midland Chamber of Commerce film which is used to explain the petroleum industry to government and congressional leaders. <br> Following the critique, Morton was questioned by a panel of four Midland oil and business executives.
