Additional rains have visited the en-dre area surrounding Muleshoe the past week, many communities report-ing as much as one and one-half inches ast Saturday evening. Although at there places near here only light show-ers were reported on that date, rains on Monday and Tuesday afternoons and night have furnished sufficient moisture for crops which are up and those that are yet to be planted. A total of 1.19 inches of rainfall was re-porded here for Saturday, Monday and Tuesday.
