In other words the United States outside of the West North' Central States does not produce as much wheat as it requires. <br> For the current somsumption year the East North Central States have a wheat surplus of $54,500,000$ bushels, and the Rocky Mountain and Pacific Statees a surplus of 58,000 ,000 bushels.
