SPEAKING OF HENS.

Iron Sulphate is used in the exact quantity as an appetizer and we absolutely know the correct amount that should be used, too much might have a harmfal effect and not enough would do no good whatever. 8.h. Sulphate of Soda in the correct amount is used as a cleanser to the stomach and intestines, too much would have a tendency to scour both cattle and sheep by making their bowels too loose, which would be harmful, while just enough is beneficial as a laxative.
