Potential Alternative to Oral Diabetes Treatment: Acarbose prevents bnormally high levels of blood glucose after eating. When German researchers administered this drug to 94 patients with non-insulin-dependent diabetes who could not control their disease with diet alone, the patients' fasting blood glucose was lowered. However, there was a more significant decrease of hyperglycemia and a lowering of triglyceride concentrations after eating. Thus, the drug not only helps to control diabetes, but may improve the patient's coronary


