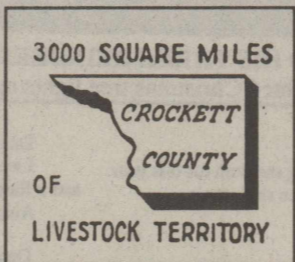

Ozona School Maintenance Supervisor To Resign In March

Members of the Ozona School Board in their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, Dec. 15, heard a report from school maintenance supervisor Curtis Keith regarding the condition of the school tennis courts and grandstands at Lions Stadium.

Mr. Keith first reported that the school tennis courts have numerous holes in them which need to be repaired before district tennis competition begins, and the courts also have many uneven spots which will require resurfacing. After discussion of the condition of the tennis courts, the members voted to authorize Keith to proceed with his plans to restore the courts to a playable condition.

The maintenance supervisor also said that many of the wood walkboards in the school stadium stands on both sides of the football field need to be replaced, and for maintenance and safety reasons, he was recommending replacement of the walkboards with aluminum instead of wood. The board voted to allow him to secure proposals from stadium seating companies and bring the proposals to their January meeting for consideration.

Mr. Keith also informed the trustees that he had purchased a business in Ruidoso, NM, and would resign his maintenance position on March 1.

The members reviewed and discussed a proposal by reading consultant Dr. William Rupley to develop a battery of reading assessment instruments for the reading programs at Ozona Primary School and Ozona Intermediate School. The consensus of the board on this issue was to postpone a response to this proposal until a new superintendent was employed.

The need for a communications system for school bus route drivers who have long routes on low-traveled roads in the county was discussed, and the trustees requested school transportation supervisor Pete Maldonado to make a study of the various types of bus communication systems and give a report at the next meeting.

During the meeting the members also approved the annual audit report for the 1992-93 school year as prepared by the accounting firm of Eckert, Ingram, Tinkler, Oliphant, and Featherston, and they voted to set the January regular board meeting on Jan. 12, at 7:00 p.m.

33,000 Pecos River Fish Killed

AUSTIN - An estimated 33,000 fish of several species were killed in an algae bloom along 110 miles of the Pecos River in November, the fourth fish kill from this alga in nine years. The fish loss was not as bad as the previous kills.

Biologists with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and other agencies have determined that an estimated 33,110 fish were killed as the result of a bloom of the biotoxic golden alga, *Prymnesium parvum*. Kills from the same alga killed 111,500 fish in 1985 and 525,600 fish in 1986 in this

section of the Pecos River.

The bloom was first reported Nov. 3 and continued for two weeks, said Jack Ralph, field response coordinator for TPWD's resource protection division. An investigation was conducted between the U. S. 290 bridge east of Sheffield on the Pecos and Crockett County lines to Pandale in northwestern Val Verde County.

Ralph said biologists don't know how to control the alga. "There's nothing that can be done. We don't know

Rep. Bonilla And Sen. Bill Sims Visit With Producers

U.S. Representative Henry Bonilla and State Senator Bill Sims visited Ozona last Wednesday at Wool Growers Central Storage where they met with local producers and discussed the Wool Act and incentive program. Rep. Bonilla told ranchers that the battle to get the incentive payments intact through 1993 was uphill all the way. "It was the toughest thing that I have ever encountered in my entire

career and my life as far as that goes," said Bonilla.

Pleas Childress asked if there would be money available for the coming two years before the incentive program reaches the chopping block in '95. Bonilla answered, "Yes, we have nothing to worry about. These men will uphold their word, even though a vote must be taken to appropriate the

money each year.

Bonilla said in response to a question regarding a substitute for the incentive program, "There will possibly be low interest government loans available to producers which could be used in conjunction with wool and mohair market prices and what the producer actually gets for his hair and wool."

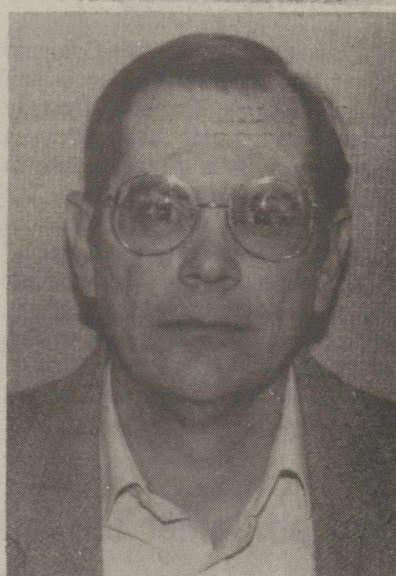
Burl Myers Asks For Election

V.P. Gore's Report: It Doesn't Practice What It Is Preaching

The following article was published in the December 1993 issue of the *National Lamb & Wool Grower*. It was supposed to cost 90 cents each. It ended up costing \$4 apiece. And that's just what has the critics laughing. The objet d'raport belongs to none other than Vice President Gore and ironically is entitled, "Creating A Government That Works Better and Costs Less".

An internal memo from the Government Printing Office says the thrice-increased cost is attributable to the fact the report was printed on the most expensive slick, heavy paper in red, blue and black ink. Also adding to the higher price tag: the job was delivered to the printers at the last second, requiring a crash effort over the Labor Day Weekend - although it had been commissioned six months earlier.

Gore's office doesn't dispute the figures, which totaled \$168,915 instead of the first-estimated cost of \$54,091.
