

here. I recently had the experience of driving up to the gas pump and paying substantially less than \$1.10 per gallon for unleaded. Upon reflection I suppose I should say in my best and only Russian phrase "Thank you, Valadamir". That's because Russian policy, together with the economic recession, is helping keep prices down. It pains me to thank the Russians for very much, having grown up during the days of The Cold War. But economic facts are economic facts gasoline prices are at a two year low.

Russia has so far refused to make more than token concessions to Saudi Arabia's plea for export cutbacks to keep prices from spiraling in a downward spin. The importance, economic and political, of the move by the world's number 2 oil exporter to increase its share of the market at the expense of Middle East suppliers can scarcely be overestimated.

World Petroleum prices under \$20 per barrel and declining can have the effect of putting \$150 billion dollars or more into our recessionary economy. A lot of this will go into the pocket of the consumer, though not the landowner who has lots of open country for oil lease exploration. This in itself pains me a lot. I have to recognize though that at this rate Russia may be doing a lot more than the U. S. Congress to provide us with some kind of antirecession stimulus.

Russia's largely privatized oil industry has its own reasons for turning up this spigot, but President Vladamir Putin has been quick to reap some political dividends. He has presented Russia's oil policy as an act of solidarity with the antiterrorist coalition, saying that Russia can well serve the West as an alternate source of energy to the unstable and radical Middle East. He seems totally unconcerned that a price war may, in fact, contribute to destabilizing shaky emirates in the Persian Gulf region. When oil prices fell to \$10 a barrel three years ago, Saudi Arabia had to borrow money for the very first time in its history to cover its welfare-state budget. And Saudi Arabia, our alleged friend, faces even more trouble if Russia is Christian. not induced to join in cutting oil exto reduce oil exports next year. This 13:2. threatens to defeat the plan of the OPEC countries to bolster declining but for me Johnny Perkins is one. prices.

I am somewhat skeptical as to whether trading one energy dependency for another is in our best consumer's interest. But for now, I guess most of Americans can enjoy these prices at the pump that the Russians helped bring about.
