Reckless drivers, fires, theft, traffic accidents in law reports

Reckless drivers, two fires, a theft, and one accident were among reports from Lynn County Sheriff's Office this week, and the Tahoka Police Dept. released information on four traffic accidents in Tahoka that occurred during the past two weeks.

Tahoka Volunteer Fire Dept. was called to the scene of a vehicle on fire on T-Bar Ranch property west of FM 3112 on CR. 28 Monday afternoon about 4:15. The vehicle was fully engulfed in flames when the fire department arrived, and about a quarter of an acre of grass was also on fire. Flames were extinguished, and no injuries were reported.

New Home Volunteer Fire Dept. responded to a barn on fire at 1154 FM 211 last Friday at 8:51 a.m. No injuries were reported.

Several reckless driver reports were in the call sheets, including one west of New Home city limits on FM 211 at 5:30 p.m. Monday. A caller told officers that a

gray 4-door Chevy pickup had been stopped in the ditch and then continued driving but was on the wrong side of the road. A deputy stopped the vehicle south of CR 3 on FM 1730. The driver was an elderly male, who was taken by Lynn County EMS to Lynn County Hospital to be checked out for medical issues. The vehicle was released to the man's wife.

Another report of reckless driving ended with the driver arrested. A caller told the Sheriff's Office that he was behind a gray car that was swerving on US 87 about 8 miles north of Tahoka, driven by a female that was talking on her phone. Deputies stopped the vehicle 4 miles south of Tahoka on US 87, and the driver, a woman from Odessa, was arrested on charges of Driving While License Suspended/Invalid.

A red sedan was found abandoned at 11:51 a.m. Saturday about a half mile west of Lubbock Shoot-

Thriftway Grocery store in Tahoka is now Cash Saver Cost Plus Supermarket. Thriftway owner Steve Sanders sold the store to the Lawrence Management Group of Sweetwater, and the store was closed last Wednesday, Thursday and Friday during the transition from an Affiliated Foods store to the new Cash Saver Supermarket, reopening on Saturday, Nov 3.

Jay and Kyle Lawrence are the new owners of Cash Saver, and the brothers were in Tahoka overseeing the transition of the store last week.

"We are very happy to be here," Kyle told *The News*. "We love the smaller market, and we believe that the Cash Saver Supermarket will do well here."

He explained that the Cash Saver prices are based on the cost of the product and cost of delivery to the store, with the store then adding an additional 10 percent to the cost

at checkout.

"We believe the customers here will see lower prices on many of the grocery items," Lawrence said.

Joseph Copeland is the new Store Manager. He brings with him more than 24 years experience of managing Walmart stores. He and his wife, Jenn, have two children, a son Cooper, and daughter Kenadie. He is commuting to Tahoka from Levelland, but says he very much wants to become involved with the community here.

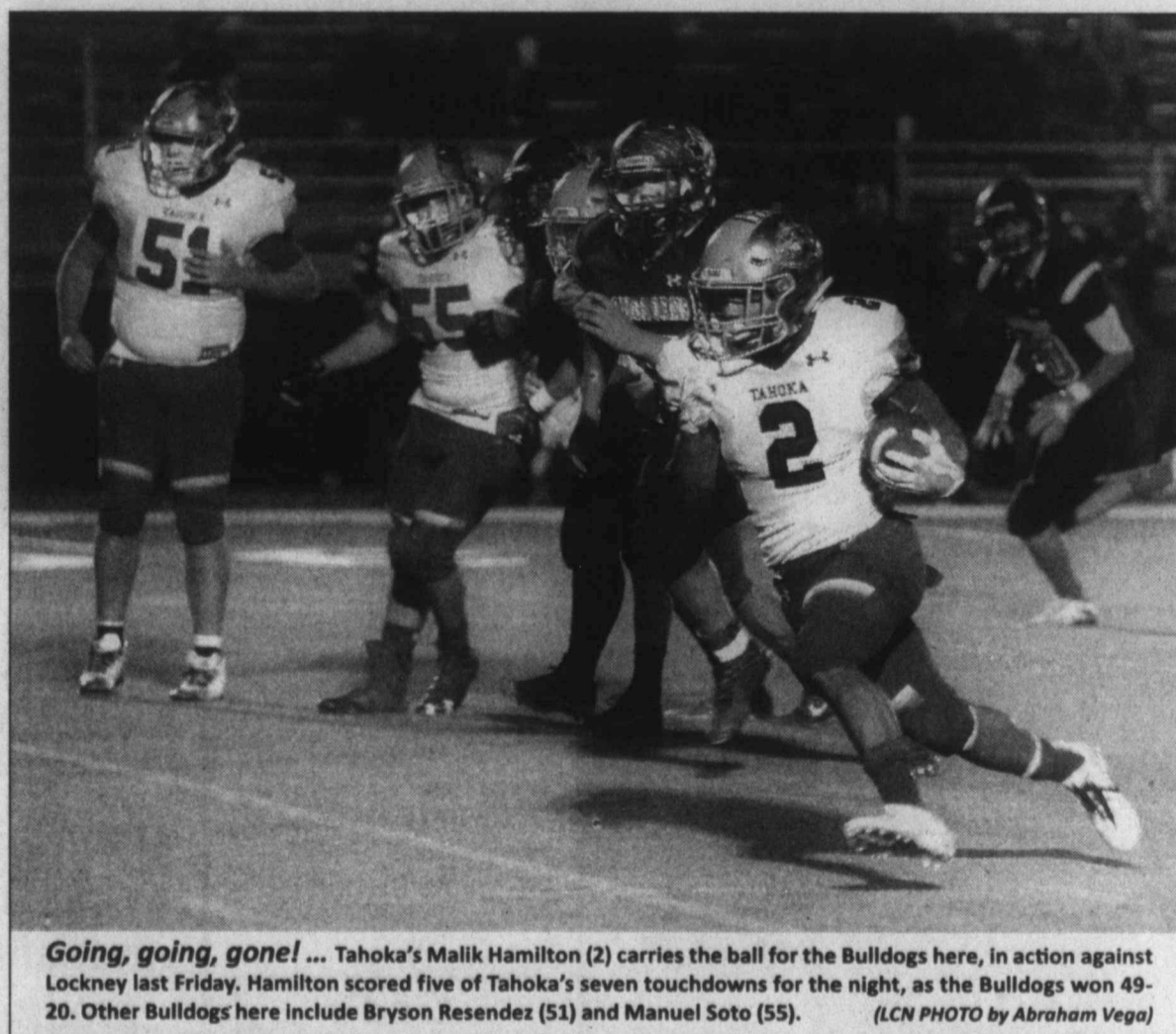

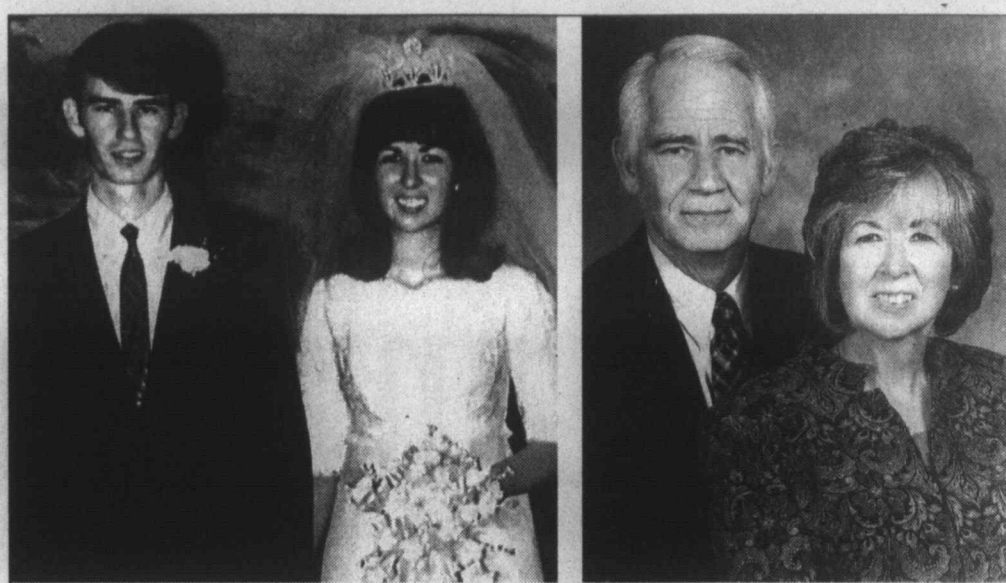
her family and was a member of Tahoka Trinity Church.

Couple to celebrate 50th anniversary

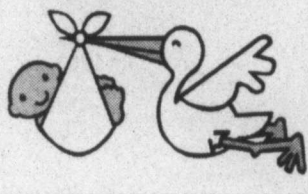

Following the Apostle Paul ... Max Spears, a land owner in Lynn County, recently went on an "Steps of the Apostle Paul and the Early Church Tour" with Biblical Archaeologist, Dr. Jim Fleming (www.biblicalresources.net). Max is standing in front of the Library at Ephesus. The city was first inhabited at the end of the Bronze Age in approximately 1,200 BC. In the 1st century BC, Ephesus was the 3rd largest city in the Roman Empire, behind Rome and Alexandria, with a population of about 250,000. The theater there seated 25,000 which was the largest in the world at the time. Paul spent 3 years here on his 3rd missionary journey, from 53-56 AD, where he taught daily and wrote the letters to the Ephesians that appear in 1st Corinthians. Discovered in 1878 - only 20% has been excavated so far. *The News* is 6,537 miles from Tahoka.

ing complex on CR 1, which DPS had towed away. The vehicle was registered to Edward Rangel Jr. of Lubbock.

On Oct. 23, a 2011 white Chevrolet Silverado C3500 pulling a trailer struck a powerline pole at the intersection of Hwy 380 and the US 87 access road. The truck was owned by Green Country, a business in Dumas, and the driver was Manuel Fra Young. No injuries were reported.

On Oct. 28, Juwan Mitchell Hamilton was the driver of a 2010 white Ford F150 that struck a 2005 white Chevrolet Silverado driven by Patrick D'Anthony Herrera in the 1700 block of Lockwood Street while attempting a left turn into a parking lot at 6:20 p.m. No injuries were reported.

On Oct. 29 at 11:48 a.m., a 2013 GMC Acadia driven by Amie Lynne Saucedo struck a 2014 Ford F150 driven by Donna Hall Schuknecht in the parking lot of the Tahoka Post Office at 1525 Conway Street. No injuries were reported.

A hit and run is still under investigation by Tahoka Police that occurred at 5:20 a.m. Sunday, Nov. 4. A 2006 Dodge Charger owned by Ricardo Quintero reportedly struck a 2002 Cadillac parked by the curb in the 1800 block of Ave. L, owned by Brian Alvarado. The driver of the Dodge Charger reportedly left the vehicle at the scene, but walked away from the scene before police arrived.

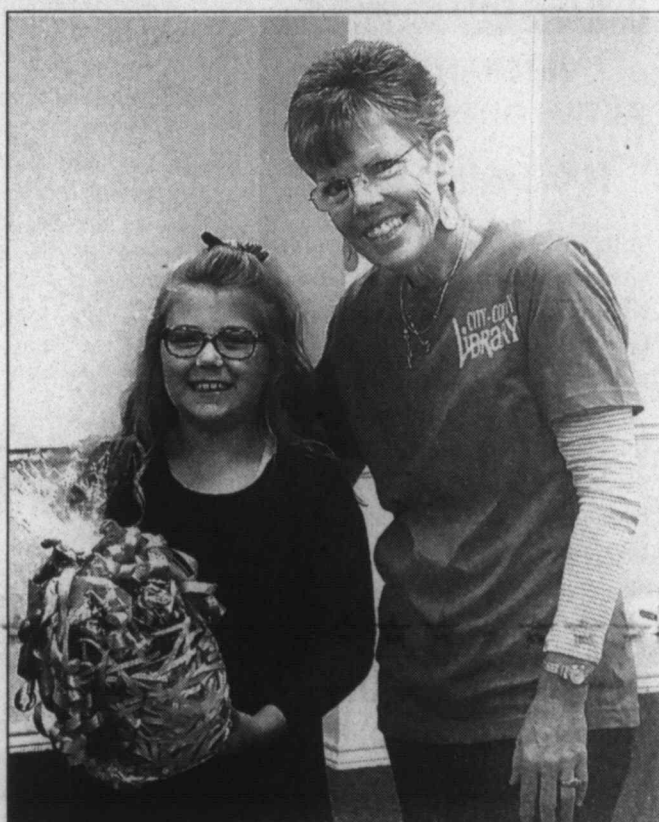

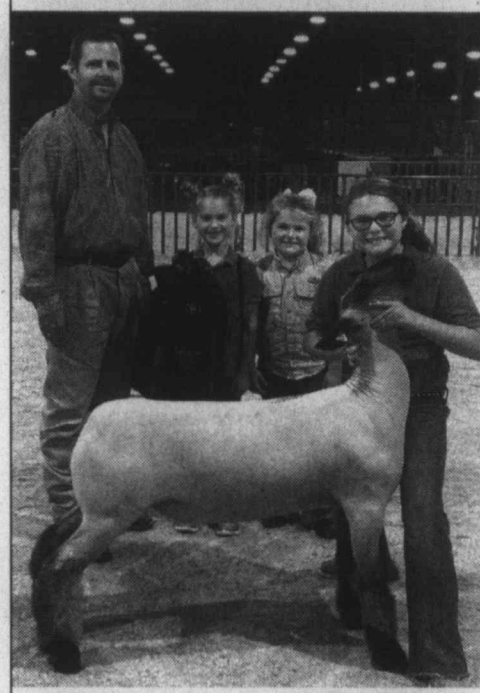

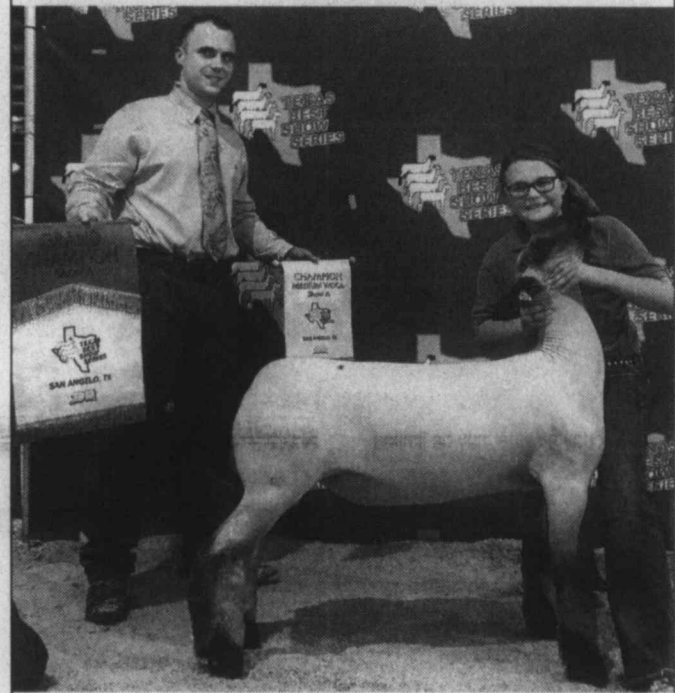
