Report of the Secretary of the Navy.

The report of Secretary Robeson, of the Navy Department, is at hand and, although containing much that is merely technical, possesses many facts of great interest to the general public. The navy now consists of 179 ships, of all classes and all conditions, calculated to carry 1,390 guns, exclusive of howitzers and small carronades. Of these ships 29 are sailing vessels and the remainder sidewheel steamers, or sailing vessels with auxiliary serews. Fifty-three of these yessels, carrying ty-three of these vessels, carrying 601 guns, are in the service in varions capacities; 6 are nearly ready for sea; 52 are monitors, only one of which is now in commission, the remainder being laid up at the va-zious stations; 17 are under repair at the various yards; 13 are on the stocks, never having been com-pleted and launched; and the balance are laid up in ordinary. Of these last, the largest proportion the Secretary does not believe worth the repairing, they having been built with great rapidity and haste, and of the most imperfect mater-
