Tax Becords.

There seems to prevail a general impression that the Comptroller of the State is able to furnish exact information concerning the pay ment of taxes not only upon town or city property, but upon tracts of is misplaced. Three, or five, of that body land, no matter where situated. This is a mistake. The Comptroller can certify who has paid taxes, and the amounts paid, but he has no means of describing the property. It is, indeed, an exception to the rule when his books show anything whereby the property taxed can be identified. Take any lot in San Antonio, for instance; it may be described as a lot on such and such a street, but without a number, and without giving the dimensions. There is no possibility of identification. Any certificate for purposes of information, or litigation, which you may obtain from that officer is valueless. Go to the county records and you are equally baffled. It is only by accident that you are able to discover any valuable intormation concerning the assessment and payment of taxes upon real property.

This state of affairs has existed since - time immemorial. It is a diagrace to the State, and a fruitful source of litigation.


