Fatal Railroad Accident. AUSTIN, March 5. Peter Cutler, a cook in a hotel, was run over last night by an incoming passenger train, and had an arm and leg so badly fractured that amputation was necessary. He died in the surgeon's hands, while undergoing the operation.

The Coming Drive of Texas Cattle. [From the Kansas City Price Current and Live Stock Reporter, Feb. 19.] We are warranted by late and direct information from Texas in predicting that the drive from that State will be at least equal, if not exceed, the drive of 1874. Advice to one firm alone tell of over 80,000 head destined to this market.

W. B. Grimes, of Trespalacio, writes that he will start about the last of March with 1000 yearlings, 1000 two year olds, 1000 three year old cows, 1000 three year steers, and a like number of four year old stoves, making a total of 5000 head in his drive. Messrs. Ellison & Dewas will drive about 19000 head of mixed cattle, mainly beefs - Millet & Mabey will have 30,000 head, of which number about two-thirds are beefs, and the rest stock cattle.

Deworth & Littlefield will drive 13,000 head, the greater part being beefs. J. W. Simpson has 4000 mixed cattle, beefs and stockers. E. B. Allen will drive 4000 head, Scott & Mangum 2000 head, E. C. Scott 2000 head, Chas. Slanger 2000 head, A. C. Burnett 2000, James Reed 2000. Hickey will bring 1000, W. H. Kyle 8000 head, Rutledge 1000, J. Driscoll 4000, mostly beefs, and Billy Barton will come with 2000 head. The above list gives a grand total of 92,000 cattle destined for this market, and these are but a few

from the vast herds that will soon be on the trail leading to Kansas City, and heavy cattle men are yet to be heard from. For years we have listened to the sad voice of the Texas cattle drover, as he mournfully declared, "These are the last of our cattle," and still the end is not yet, but the vast breeding grounds of that State continue to pour forth herds to feed a world.

The prospects for an active market and high prices during the coming season are unusually good. Several causes have reduced the supply of cattle in Kansas, Nebraska, Missouri, Iowa and Illinois, much below the needs of those States. They must have cattle, and will seek them in the best market; therefore, we feel justified in predicting not only that the drive will be heavy, but that those who bring their "long-horns" here will be able to go back with light hearts and heavy purses.
