Synopsis of Acts Passed by the 14th Legislature.

ACT repealing an act to release residents or frontier counties from payment of taxes. ACT to regulate Public Roads. County Courts shall classify public roads into first, second and third class.

They may be interrogated, and to keep secret all proceedings which may be had in their presence, and true answers to be made to such questions as may be propounded by the grand jury...

ACT extending time for construction of works of internal improvement. The time in which their charters or laws require portions of sections to be completed is extended twelve months...

The Act Providing for City Public Schools

Below we give the full text of an act passed by the last Legislature...

Below we give the full text of an act passed by the last Legislature allowing incorporated towns and cities to assume control and management of the public schools...

There is no interest of equal importance to that of education; it is the very ground-work of our future prosperity as a community. Far better let our streets remain guano-mired and mud holes, to produce fungi, than that a thousand young San Antonians grow up in stolid ignorance to be food for our police courts and penitentiaries hereafter.

We are glad the opportunity is offered our new city administration to redeem the pledges of reform made before the election. As soon as the city accepts the terms of the act, all taxation for public schools paid by all citizens...

San Antonio is most favorably situated to take advantage of this act. She owns two fine school buildings and will be entitled to the building in the fourth Ward purchased by the State...

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas, That whenever any incorporated city or town shall have adopted this act...

Section 2. Any incorporated city that may undertake to provide for the gratuitous education of all the children of school age within its limits, shall be omitted from the school district...

Section 3. When any such incorporated city assumes the control of the public schools within its limits, the County Board of School Directors may, when it is deemed expedient, restrict the territory left under their control to the unincorporated portions of the school district...

Section 4. Schools so organized and provided for by such incorporated cities shall be subject to the general laws of the State as to public education, and be under the supervision of the Department of Education in like manner as all other public schools in the State.

Section 7. Any city accepting the provisions of this act shall notify the county Superintendent of the county and the Superintendent of Public Instruction, of its action, by sending them a certified copy of the resolutions of the City Council by which such acceptance is made.

Section 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
