A REPUBLICAN VICTORY.
President, R. L. April 15.—The second trial in this case to elect a Senator and nine Representatives in the General Assembly resulted in a decisive Republican victory, supported by the liquor interest, by 350 majority. A stand on which were 1500 people gave way and precipitated the entire mass to the ground. Thirty persons were injured. The rioters, indulged at the instigation of the proprietors, destroyed everything on the grounds, and burned the barricades around them.
