It was the first ever seen, and its merits and demerits were discussed by the men. Opinions differed as to its superior qualities. One of the men re-marked that he had heard that it would kill at the distance of a mile. Younger replied, 'If that is so the force of the dis charge must be terrific.' Another banteringly remarked, that if the new gun would kill a mile distance, the ball at short range would go through ten men. Younger raised up from the saddle on which he was altting and remarked: That is easy to demonstrate. When felt sure their time was come.
