BRITISH OPINIONS ON THE SITUATION.

From the London Times, Nov. 24. No doubt the Republicans have all the advantages of possession, and the Democrats would be too wise, even were they not too weak, to resist violently the overwhelming force that would sustain Mr. Hayes' inauguration. But a Republican Administration so placed in power would be discredited abroad and weakened by divisions at home.

NO FINAL ARBITRAMENT.

Upon the Republican interpretation of this, the President of the Senate has merely to reckon the votes appearing upon the face of the certified returns, and as Mr. Ferry is a Republican politician, he will not in all probability take any exception of his own accord to the votes given for Mr. Hayes. The question then arises, whether the House of Representatives, claiming to reject certain of Mr. Hayes' votes, can appeal to any final arbitrament. Nothing of the kind seems to have been provided, as no crisis like the present was anticipated by the framers of the Constitution.

THE ELECTION SHOULD BE UNQUESTIONED

Had Mr. Hayes been chosen by a majority on an unquestioned vote, the South would, most likely, have acquiesced in its defeat with as good a grace as usual. But his advantage can not now be given him; and without it he had better not go to the White House at all. His doubtful success would, probably, be worse for his party, and would certainly be less desirable for the country than his failure. He has come near enough to take off much of the value of the Democratic victory, and to encourage the Republicans to return to the struggle at the Congressional elections two years hence, and at the Presidential election in 1880, with a reformed policy and clean hands. The party might thus profit by a period of adversity, especially as it would come in a form which would make it light to bear, and not impossible to change into prosperity in the near future.

SEVERAL QUESTIONS IN DOUBT

Writing of the mode of electing the President of the United States one of the authors of the Federalist complacently observes that, "in the manner of it be not perfect, it is at least excellent." Something might perhaps be said against this, especially in view of the present difficulties in Louisiana, South Carolina, and elsewhere. Have the Supreme Courts of the various States any right to interfere, as that of South Carolina is stated to have done, and to issue a mandamus to the Returning Board? Or is it left, as Chancellor Kent apparently thinks, to the President of the Senate to determine, when, in the presence of both Houses of Congress, he opens the sealed certificates, the validity of each vote? On these points more or less obscurely reigns. It is perfectly true that Congress has asserted the power to declare the certificates of a particular State objectionable, but the law is no longer binding. It may be doubtful, too, whether it ever was constitutional, for not merely is there Chancellor Kent's authority for believing that Congress may interfere "only if no choice be made," but the words of the Constitution point rather to the State Legislatures determining, in the fullest sense, the manner of appointment.

THE USE OF ARMED FORCE EXPECTED.

From the London Standard, Nov. 21. If the votes of Florida or Louisiana should be tainted by fraud, or strong suspicion of fraud or illegality, the House of Representatives, when the votes are to be finally counted and declared on one side or the other, will exercise the right it claims to cast them out. In that case supposing the right to be admitted, Mr. Tilden would be elected. But it is almost equally certain that the Republican majority in the Senate will dispute the claim of the House. The formal duty of declaring the vote belongs to the President of the Senate, and he, being, of course, a Republican nominee, will very probably, in the last resort, declare Hayes elected in spite of the resistance of the House. In that case there can be little doubt that the Gen. Grant would decide the de facto possession of the Presidency and the White House by forcibly keeping the Democrats away at the decisive moment of his own resignation, and formally installing Mr. Hayes as his successor. The practical power of determining the election, or at least the tenure of the Presidency, would rest with the army; for the army is the one symbol of Federal power to which the South must and will in almost any case submit. The guilt of the party who have determined either actually to bring about such a result, or at least to screen or not to repudiate that violent section which has

resolved to bring it about, can hardly be exaggerated. The installation of a President rejected by the popular vote, through the agency of force or fraud, would give a shock to the Constitution such as it might never recover, and would expose to extreme danger the peace of the country, and not improbably the existence of the Union.

THE DEATH OF THE HOPPER.

[From the Saline (Kas.) Journal.] Reports from all parts of the State are to the effect that nearly all of the eggs deposited by grasshoppers had hatched during the recent warm weather, and that the storms and cold weather of last week was the means of destroying the young hoppers. The reports are so well substantiated as to leave little doubt that we will be relieved of much of the trouble anticipated from these pests next spring. We have talked with men from all parts of Saline and from adjoining counties, who assured us that they had personally investigated the condition of the egg deposits in their localities, and they had found that in most cases the eggs, backs and legs of young grasshoppers had formed, but life was apparently extinct. The indications are that this section will be comparatively free of the hoppers in the spring.
