3 cups prepared fruit (1 orange, 1 lemon, 1 small grapefruit); 5 cups (21/4 lbs.) granulated sugar; 1/2 bottle Certo fruit

Remove skins in quarters from the fruit. Lay flat; shave off and discard about half of white part. With a sharp knife slice remaining rind very fine. 



### OLD AGE BENEFITS ARE CHANGED

One of the recent changes in the Social Security Act is important to all persons who work between the ages of 62 and 72, according to Floyd B. Ellington, Manager of the San Angelo social security office.

"This change concerns the 'earnings test' the amount one may earn and still receive some payments,' he said. Earned income of \$1200 or less in a year has no effect on the benefits. Now, however, only \$1 in benefits is withheld for each dollar earned in excess of that amount,' he continued.

"This means that in some cases where a man and wife are both of retirement age, he can earn as much as \$3.000 a year and still recieve some old age retirement age, he can earn as much as \$3,000 a year and still receive some old age insurance. Where there are three or more beneficiaries in one worker's family, it is possible for him to earn as much as \$4,000 and receive some family payments for the same

After age 72, there is no retirement test, Mr. Ellington believes that there are many workers in the District between age 62 72 who should apply for the benefits to avoid any possible loss. Claims may be filed with the Social Security Administration office at San Angelo, Texas.

### Some Benefits for Workers Who Continue to Work After Rettirement Age

Then, for each \$1 he earns over \$1700, an additional \$1 is withheld.

the American Forest Products Industries, Inc. The youth was one of 12 4-H'ers from different parts of the country to earn trips to the event through excellence in forestry.


