## State Bar Column

### REASONABLE TIME

Before a contract arises someone must make an offer and another must accept it. Without an offer, no acceptance; with no acceptance, no agreement.

But there is often a time within which you can accept the offer. And if not, the offer ends anyhow within a "reasonable time" which is determined by circumstances and the parties' intentions.

Smith had a set of books which Brown wanted. Brown wrote and offered him \$200 for the set. Smith didn't answer for six months, and meantime Brown bought a similar set. One day Brown got a letter from Smith saying "I accept your offer of \$200 for the set of books."

Brown told Smith he'd bought the books elsewhere, but Smith still claimed that his belated "acceptance" had nevertheless sealed the contract with Brown.

Was there a contract? No, the offer had lapsed because it had not been accepted in the circumstances within a reasonable time.

There are many ways to end an offer. You may withdraw it, you may say that the offer expires at a given time, or you may die, or the other party may turn it down directly or by making a counter offer.

Here Smith had failed to accept Brown's offer within a reasonable time, which ended it just as though it had been withdrawn.

What is reasonable time? It varies. The offer could expire in a few minutes in the stock market or last for quite a while, depending upon what a court would think is a reasonable time.

But in Smith's case six months was unreasonable.

**REQUEST FORM**—Every person under 21 years of age, unless married, must present this form, properly filled out and signed, to receive his Sabin poliomyelitis vaccine dose Sept. 3. The form above may be clipped from the paper, filled out and presented to the doctors or nurses at the time the vaccine is received. By having the form already filled out, a juvenile can receive his vaccine within the shortest possible time. His parent or guardian must sign the request form, and the signature must be witnessed by two persons. The witness may be any adults, including relatives. If a form is not filed out for a juvenile when he arrives to take his vaccine, it will require waiting in line. Request forms will be available at the vaccine stations.

## For a Beautiful Cake!

HEAVENLY frosting, delicately honey-flavored, and covered with frosty-white flaked coconut, makes a "beauty" out of the simplest of cakes! You can use bakers' cake layers; or you can make layers or a large loaf from a mix, or from your own favorite recipe.

### Coconut Honey Frosting

3 egg whites; 1 1/2 cups sugar; 1/2 teaspoon salt; 1/2 cup water; 2 tablespoons light corn syrup; 2 tablespoons honey; 1/2 teaspoon vanilla; 1/4 cup Angel Flake Coconut.

Combine egg whites, sugar, salt, water, corn syrup, and honey in top of double boiler. Beat 1 minute until thoroughly mixed. Cook over rapidly boiling water, beating constantly with sturdy egg beater (or at high speed of electric beater) 7 minutes. Remove from boiling water. Add vanilla and beat 1 minute or until thick enough to spread. Frost cake and sprinkle with flaked coconut. Makes 5 1/4 cups frosting or enough to cover generously tops and sides of two 9-inch layers.

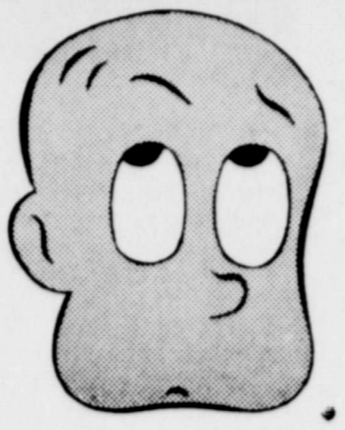

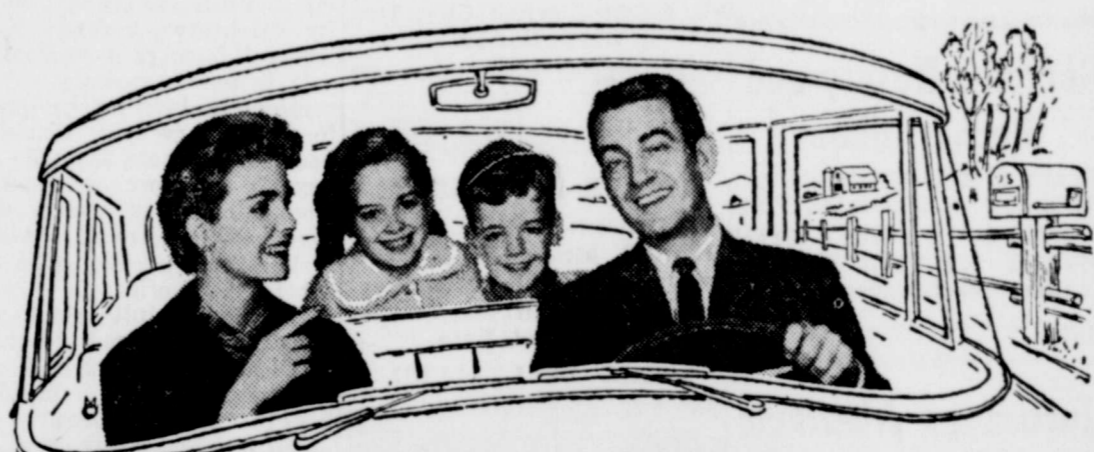

W.N. and L.R. Reed are treedoing cedar and chemical spraying prickly pear and cactus. The work is being done as a part of their Great Conservation Program.

Elliott and Ruth Collins Mendenhall have just completed treedoing approximately 129 acres of cedar on their Coke County Ranch. Mendenhall expects to complete a pasture of mesquite treedoing in the near future.

S.K. Horwood has recently completed a pipeline for live-stock water and cross-fenced a 5 1/2 section pasture to improve grazing distribution.

October 2 is the date set for the election of supervisor in the Tom Green County zone of the North Concho River District. Residents of the Tom Green Zone who own land in the District are eligible voters. Fred Gunter of the Experiment Service and Leo Merrill of the Experiment Station will be on the program. Exact time of day and place will be announced.

Supervisors of the District recently donated \$25.00 to help get soil conservation education intergrated into the public schools. The money was donated in response to a request by the Texas Association of Soil Conservation Districts.

There are six Great Plains Contracts in Sterling County. Total Cost-sharing in contracts is \$105,510.00. Twenty Glasscock land operators have Great Plains Contracts. Cost sharing is \$232,201.80.

### DISABLED MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR SOCIAL SECURITY

Over fifty million people have worked long enough under social security to qualify for cash disability benefits if they become disabled. This means that they have social security credits for five years (20 quarters) out of the past ten years, Floyd B. Ellington, district manager of the San Angelo Social Security office said. In the case of a severe disability, the worker and his dependents may be eligible for monthly cash social security disability benefits if he meets this work requirement.

It is not necessary to be completely helpless to qualify for social security disability benefits. These benefits are payable to those who suffer from a crippling disease or a severe impairment which makes them unable to do any substantial work.

Disabled adult sons and daughters of retired, deceased, or disabled workers may also receive childhood disability benefits if they become disabled before they reached age

18. Anyone suffering a severe disability which prevents him from doing any substantial work should get in touch with the local social security office to determine his eligibility under the Social Security disability program. Ellington stated. He may be losing benefits if he fails to apply for them promptly. The social security district office will explain to disabled workers and their families their rights under the law.

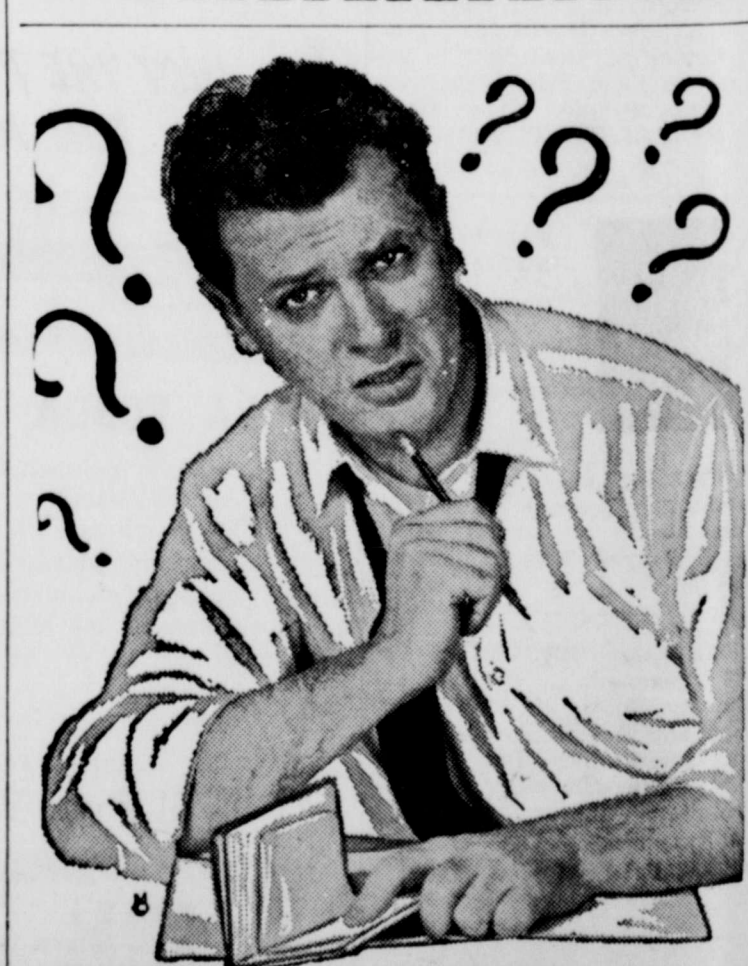
