



For a Beautiful Cake!

HEAVENLY frosting, delicately honey-flavored, and covered with frosty-white flaked coco-



nut, makes a "beauty" out of the simplest of cakes! You can use bakers' cake layers; or you can make ayers or a large loaf from a mix, or from your own fa-

Coconut Honey Frosting

2 egg whites; 1½ cups sugar; ½ teaspoon salt; ⅓ cup water; tablespoons light corn syrup; spoon vanilla; ¾ cup Angel Flake Coconut.

Combine egg whites, sugar, salt, water, corn syrup, and honey in top of double boiler. Beat 1 minute until thoroughly mixed. Cook over rapidly boiling water, beating constantly with sturdy egg beater (or at high speed of electric beater) 7 minutes. Remove from boiling water. Add vanilla and beat 1 minute or until thick enough to spread. Frost cake and sprinkle with flaked coconut. Makes 51/4 cups frosting or enough to cover generously tops and sides of two 9-inch layers.

a ''hostess gift." Three-Fruit Marmalade 3 cups pre-

pared fruit (1 orange, 1 lemon, 1 small grapefruit); 5 cups (21/4 lbs.) granulated sugar; 1/2 bottle Certo fruit

Remove skins in quarters from the fruit. Lay flat; shave off and discard about half of white part. With a sharp knife slice remaining rind very fine. Add 1½ cups water and ½ teaspoon soda; bring to a boil; simmer, covered 20 minutes, stirring occasionally. Chop peeled fruit; discard seeds. Add pulp and juice to undrained cooked rind. Simmer, covered, 10 minutes longer. Measure 3 cups

into a very large saucepan. Add sugar to fruit in saucepan and mix well. Place over high heat, bring to a full rolling boil; boil hard 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and at once stir in Certo. Skim foam with metal spoon. Stir and skim by turns for 7 minutes to prevent floating fruit. Ladle into glasses. Cover with 1/8 inch hot paraffin. Makes 7 medium glasses.
