Columbus, O., June 4.—The democratic convention organized here to day by the election of Samuel F. Hurd, of Cincinnati, chairman. The following ticket was nominated: For governor, Thoa. Ewing, of Fairfield, Lt., governor, A. V. Rice, of Putuan; treasurer, Anthony Howell, of Stark; judge of the suprome court, W. J. Gilmore, of Preble; attorney-general, S. P. Mars, of Allea. The platform adopted demands fair elections without laterference of the military power and says that have enacted by congress, which under pretense of regulating congressional elections interfere with the election of state officers and overthrow the laws of the state governments, and the choice of auch officers, are unconstitutional and ought to be repealed. It demands a change in the federal jury laws so that juries cannot be packed and controlled by the government for despotic and partisan purposes as he-vetorore, and charges that the action of the president and republican minority in congress in refusing to allow supplies to be used unless the majority would conset to the wee of troops at polls, and the maintenance of unconstitutional and unjust election laws, has shown a spirit of faction and devotion to narty success insatead of to

election laws, has shown a spirit of faction election laws, has shown a spirit of faction and devotion to party success instead of to the welfare of the country, and deserves the condemnation of the whole American people. It asserts that President Hayes, by interpos-ing vetoes to defeat constitutional and well considered legislation, has disregarded the latentions of the framers of the constitution and without the statement of the constitution Intentions of the framers of the constitution and wishes and welfare of the people; that it is the sense of the democracy of Ohio that not a dollar should be appropriated by congress to pay soldiers, marshals or supervisors to interfere with the elections. The financial plank of the platform reaffirms the principles heretofore advocated by the party in Ohio, favors abolition of the present national banking system, the substitution of green-backs for national bank notes, and declares that the demonstitution of silver was a monstrous fraud on the people; and that it should be restored to its place on equality with gold.
