In your issue of the 26th inst., we notice an article headed, "Quitea Whisky Seizure," which is calculated to create an impression injurious to us. After stating that the sheriff had held an attachment against the late firm of Michael Bros., and that we was informed that equantity of liquor had been stored away by the Michaels in Berg and Bro,'s cellar, and in searching for property of that firm, wiz. Michael Bros., to levy on, he found the' cellar door open, no one knows how it came so, which resulted in the seizure of a number of barrels of whisky.

We desire to state, in connection with this article, that, as proprietors of the transfer line we have running the last eight months, transported a large amount of freight for Michael Bros., resulting in the firm's indebtedness to us of several hundred dollars for freight paid by us and cost of transportation from the railroad depot. We desired some security for our debt, and a portion of the whisky was turned over to us as security. Subsequently they desired to store in our warehouse some additional whisky, which, of course, we agreed to. This was several months before the failure, or even the existence of a surpicion of their being in a failing condition, as the dates of the warehouse recipits will show. The whisky remained on storage as all other goods stored with us remain, until storage charges are made. There was no secret or mystery connected with the storage of the goods, as insinuated by your reporter, in the article above referred to. The window in front of where this property is store is secured by an irou grating, and is open day and night. The fact of the name appearing in full on the barrels is sufficient to show that there, was no mystery glowt the storage of the goods, fand no attempt at seclusion or secreey. Very respectfully,
