

Texas had not a single defender left in all the vast region from the river Brazos to the Rio Grande, while General Houston, the commander-in-chief, who had never fought a battle, and had never ceased to retreat before the advancing enemy was in the marshes near what is now the city of Houston, in full retreat for the sanctuary to be afforded by the neutral ground of Louisiana in the United States.
