Montgomery, who departed this life at the ranch of Dr. Elliott, west of this city, last Monday, were taken through San Antonio to the home of his parents, near Lavernia, Wilson county, where they were interred yesterday. Dr. Montgomery was born at the locality where his remains will find their lasting abiding place about thirty years ago. Attaining manhood, he chose medicine as his profession, and found his loving and indulgent parents more than ready to give him every advantage that could have been desired to prepare for the field of practice. After preparatory courses in the best American colleges, he went to Europe, and about six years need of practice. He returned to his native heath and at once assumed a prominent position with the able members of his profession then gesiding here, both as a physician and a surgeon. Continuing his practice in San Antonio for some time, the future prospects of Laredo won his attention, and he decided to make the rising little border city his home. At Laredo, he succeeded well, but contracted a disease which hastened his end. It was generally believed by physicians who studied his case that his lungs were affected, and consumption is now assigned as the cause of his death. But Dr. Montgomery persisted in the belief that his affliction was of a different nature—a disease of the throat having its origin from an affection of the

And he had even asked to prove the correctness of his opinion, knowing that he must die, that a post-mortem examination be made to determine the doubt. This was not done, however.
