Care of Poultry and Chicks.

Southern Poultry Journal.

We have had in the south an unusually warm winter, and poultry pests in the shape of mites and other insects have not been killed on the roosts and in the nesting places by the cold. They have lived, and where they have not been attended to have multiplied all winter.

We are, in the far south, in the midst of the hatching season, and if unusual precautions are not taken there will be much loss experienced. Keep the roosts and floors clean, dust the laying and brooding hens with insect powder made of flour of sulphur and crude carbolic acid, a half gill of the acid to a pound of sulphur mixed and finely pulverized, rub the powder well into the hens' feathers with the hand and sprinkle some in the hostoms of the nests and in the ash-pan or wallowing place for the fowls. Make a good white-wash mixture and in every potent buckful of white-wash put a pint of cheap kerosene, (the crude kerosene is best if you can get it) and a gill of crude carbolic soid. White-wash with this mixture making it tolerably thin and putting it so as to reach and saturate all the cracks and crannies of nests and roots. Do not put it off a single day, do it at once, and do it well and you will be amply repaid for your trouble. Nothing is so deadly and destructive to freshly hatched chicks as mites. This process, if well done, will kill all insects that infest poultry, and during the spring and summer months should be repeated at least once in every two months; once a month is better if you want to make sure work.
