The torticultural display is unexcelled anywhere, the very finest cabbages, beets, turnips, earrors, onions, garlies, tomatoes, etc., being there, showing what an intelligent effort, combined with industry, will do, and what wonderful possibilities can be achieved in Texas. The fruits on exhibition called forth exchannations of surprise from several citizens of New Jersey and California who were present. They said they did not believe that Texas could produce such fruit, but admitted that this display proved that Texas would, in time, rival any state in her fruits.

Mr. A. P. Wooldridge delivered a terse and beautiful address, in which he congratulated the Germans for melr enterprise in thus demonstrating the grand possibilities of the Lone Star state in her soil productions. He said that such exhibitions as this were irrefurable árguments against all that might be said against Texas in every particular, and conduced infinitely more to her soild worth than all the horse racing, fairs, &c., that could be started.


