He thinks it will be proper to consult the latter, since they have a direct interest at each of these points. In practice, under the late custom, it has been found that many men of no business capacity whatever have succeeded in obtaining strong church indorsements, and in some cases some men have received this influence who turned out to be morally unfit for the position. The secretary says his examination of results of this system of selection has convinced him that it has proved a decided failure.
