They saw one of the other girls scrambling and splashing through the water near the bank, but just about the time they reached her she managed to reach the shore. When informed the men that Matilda had drowned, they went back to where she had been seen to sink. Houston and one of the Mexicans turned back to the spot where the girl was seen to sink, and happened to have which was attached to the long pole on which the boat was after the girl had sunk succeeded in finding her body, which was drawn up by a hook. The body was taken to the west bank of the river near Jacob Schube's residence. The body was then placed in a coffin and buried in the cemetery.
