Berry Fully Experienced In Field of Contracting

C. M. Berry, better known around these parts as Check Berry, is a man with a lot of experience in the contracting business, and is noted as one of the experts in the Pecos Valley.

He specializes in building roads, firewalls around tank batteries and digging water reservoirs for farmers. One of his biggest customers is an organization which develops potash properties near Halfway, about 70 miles southeast of Artesia.

It's the Kerr-McGeen-Farmers Union project, and Berry has made about 37 locations for the firm during the past two years. By "making a location," Check means building roads to a drill site and generally preparing the location so that equipment can be transported in to it.

Berry employs a large number of men when he is filling contracts, but actually he has only two one would call steady employees. He operates two D-8 Caterpillar bulldozers and a blade (maintainer). He rents about six trucks, depending of course upon the job needs.

Berry, who worked eight years for Artesia Contractor Sam Sanders before going into business for himself two years ago, is a Texan and hails from Austin. He is married and they have three children. One, Mrs. Earl Burnham, lives in Fort Worth. Two others, Dewana Lou and Ray Dean, live at home. Dewana Lou graduated from Artesia High School this year, and Ray Dean is just starting school.

Drop Expected In Production Of Crude Oil

DENVER, Colo., (Special)—Domestic crude oil production is expected to drop an average of 250,000 barrels daily during the next six months, as compared with the first half of 1955.

This estimate was made here today by Minor S. Jameson, Jr., assistant to the president, Independent Petroleum Association of America, in a report to the regular quarterly meeting of the Interstate Oil Compact commission.

Jameson also noted that oil imports, as now scheduled for the last half of 1955, "will exceed the levels recommended by President Eisenhower's Cabinet committee on Energy Supplies and Resources Policy by an average of about 100,000 barrels per day."

"Imports of crude oil and refined products have increased at a much faster rate than either demand or domestic production," the IPAA official noted. "Total imports will average close to 1,250,000 barrels daily for the first six months, an increase of 20 per cent over the same six months of 1954."

Jameson estimated that the market for domestic crude oil production would average only 6,500,000 barrels daily during the last half of 1955 in meeting anticipated demands and in maintaining adequate inventories, "unless there is a change in presently scheduled imports."

This production level, Jameson pointed out, "would be an increase of about 150,000 barrels daily, or 2.4 per cent, over the average 1954 production, but would be about a 250,000 barrel-per-day decrease
