Some Live Stock Items.

Fort Worth, Tex., Oct. 3.—The regular fall meeting of the Texas State Swine Breeders association will be held at the State Fair grounds at Dallas, Tex., on Tuesday, Oct. 19 at 2 o'clock p. m. for election of officers and such other business as may come before the association.

In response to an inquiry from Louisiana Hon. W. B. Tullis of the Texas state quarantine board furnishes the following: "The Texas quarantine against the state of Louisiana will expire on the 15th, of November 1897. However, in my opinion the board will adopt a regulation providing that when cattle are offered for shipment from Louisiana, destined for points in Texas, the owner shall furnish his affidavit, corroborated by two witnesses, to the effect that said cattle are healthy, said affidavit to be delivered to the railroad company and by them forwarded to the board." It is the complaint that the present quarantine is being openly violated by driving Louisiana cattle across the line and shipping from Texas points.—Dallas News.

Austin, Tex., Sept. 30.—Dr. Swearingen arrived here at 9 o'clock to-night on a special over the Houston & Texas Central railroad. He was very much fatigued after his trip and went immediately to his home. He will not have an interview with the governor until tomorrow morning. He announces that everything is becoming quiet in Houston and the scare rapidly dying out. Also that the Galveston and other quarantines against Houston are being raised, as well as the quarantine against Beaumont. The doctor says there is no yellow fever in Texas and believes now that there will be none.—Houston Post.

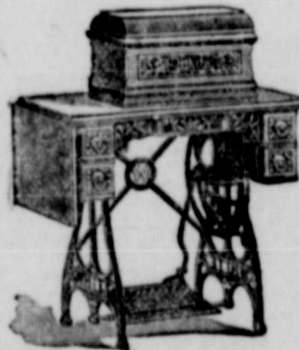
