School officials air frustration over cleanup by Ronn Smith Editor
Muleshoe school officials aired their frustration Mon day over work done by the
consultants working on the cleanup near a leaky under ground storage tank
One of the main com plaints was about testing allegedly done three years ago and only recently submitted to the Texas Natural Re sources Conservation Com mission
'The TNRCC doesn't care about the consultant; the consultant doesn't care about our money. It just amazes me how they can spend thousands and thousands of ou tax dollars," Board President Cindy Purdy said.
Superintendent David Hutton said the standard for potable water on benzene contamination is 5 parts per billion, and one well nea the old underground $\operatorname{tank}$ ha tested well above that. H said the cleanup include daily bailing of that well, process he estimated clean "If that product is migrat ing to that well, then if w can't remove all the fre product, we'll have to irri gate from city water or some other source," he said, add ing that school officials be lieve the consultant has not been doing a good job.
Discussion indicated that the district pays the consult ant when the on-site work is done and then is to be reim bursed for those expend tures - but is just now be ing reimbursed for work done in 1996.
Hutton said recent meet ings appear to have been pro ductive, adding that stat Rep. Pete Laney's office has been helpful. Hutton also said that at one meeting he asked why the TNRCC had not been more responsive in suggesting ways of dealing with the problem, one TNRCC staff member gave him a personal beeper number to u
