how. The writer has seen old bur clover laid planted in cotton or other crops, and yet the bur clover would continue to come up each fall for three years.

As a clover crop to protect and fertilize and improve the soil, it is one of the very best crops we have. As indicated above, if land is once well stocked with bur clover seed, it may be cultivated three years, and a volunteer clover crop will come up every fall and clothe the land for the winter.
