Swift Growth Expected. Teague has just returned from a trip to the district. "Present indications," he said, "point to one of the most extensive and rapid developments of a big agricultural district that has ever been witnessed even in the rapidly growing southwest. The territory is measured by hundreds of thousands of acres, and almost every available acre has been taken up. The pioneers there will not be of the usual type. Among them are some of the wealthiest citrus growers of the state, and they have plenty of capital to provide for rapid development."

WONDERFUL APPLE CROP. Menzies, Colo.—Manzonia, is marketing the greatest apple crop ever produced in this or any other section of the country, more apples per acre of orchard than any place in America. The total area of apple orchard in the Manzanola district is small, probably not to exceed 1200 acres of bearing trees, yet the crop shipped this season to date amounts to 700 cars, and a conservative estimate on the total yield is placed at 1900 cars of a shipping grade of a gross value of \$750,000.

TO RID FIELDS OF ANTS. Ants have proven to be such annoying insects that many farmers are busy in adding other insects such as the corn root louse that will pay the land owner to rid his fields of these pests as much as possible. One of the most effective ways is to thrust a crow bar into an ant hill and then pour in carbon bisulphide. The ant hill should then be covered with a blanket to prevent the fumes from escaping. The fumes will kill the ants.
